Are you protecting your intellectual property effectively? Consider this checklist as you continue to grow your business.

- 1. Business Considerations
  - Entity Type
  - Formation
- 2. Confidentiality agreements
  - Non-disclosure agreements signed by employees, developers, etc.
- 3. Ownership of intellectual property
  - Assign or transfer inventions, trademarks and other IP to the company through a legal contract
- 4. Ownership of website content
  - Assign or transfer website content to the company through a legal contract
- 5. Trademark and patent searches
  - Identify art that may bar patentability
  - Identify art that may present an infringement risk
  - Identify marks currently in use and potential infringement risk
  - Confirm that marks are available for registration
- 6. Protection of intellectual property, including:
  - Packaging look/design
  - Product design (non-functional aspects, appearance/ ornamentation)
  - Trade secrets (processes, customer list, website, packaging, social media, app GUI)
  - Trademarks, service marks, certification marks
  - Product function/configuration
- 7. Product development agreement
  - Assignment of product IP from the manufacturer/production facility to the company
