Delaware 2018) (Lead counsel: jury verdict for plaintiff finding willful patent infringement and no patent invalidity; bench trial verdict for plaintiff finding no unenforceability of U.S. Pat. No. 9,059,532 for inequitable conduct)
- *Natus Neurology Inc. v. Nox Medical Ehf*, IPR2016-01822 (PTAB March 21, 2018) (Lead counsel: decision for patent owner upholding the validity of all challenged claims of U.S. Pat. No. 9,059,532 in inter partes review)
